The story of Yellowknife is more than just that of the gold-era settlers. It is the rich tapestry of Indigenous culture, living for thousands of years on the north shore of Great Slave Lake and newcomers that grew Yellowknife from a mining outpost to a business supply centre, and then into government hub. The Museum will be one of the core attractions in Yellowknife where the history of the gold miners and early settlers in the 1930's will be showcased. The Centre is only a few minutes drive outside of Yellowknife, near the old Giant Mine site on the shores of Great Slave Lake. It will be a lovely spot to take photos of the outdoor displays and enjoy a picnic.
